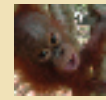

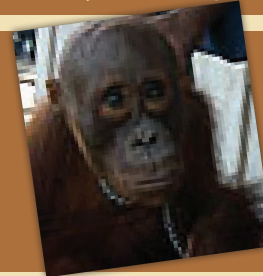
Kesi
